Some universities organize international relations as a separate department within them.

Study of political theory: includes the study of classical political philosophy and some contemporary perspectives, such as constructivism, critical theory, and postmodernism.

Public Administration: Specializes in teaching bureaucracy, which is about directing practical applications in political science. A separate department is allocated to it within the university to prepare students for civil service.

Public law: specializes in the study of constitutions, civil and criminal legal systems Public Policy: It specializes in studying the approval and implementation of government policies related to civil rights, defense, health, education, economic growth, development and environmental protection.
